Each year a committee of technical communication teachers and researchers review journals and books for work important to our activities. This year two graduate students joined the committee. Since 1975, the ATTW bibliography has appeared in the ATTW journal, originally *The Technical Writing Teacher*, now *Technical Communication Quarterly*. The ATTW website (www.attw.org) has .pdf versions of the bibliography since 1992.

Bibliographies and access to technical communication resources have expanded in recent years and take several forms. Two student-driven initiatives are taking advantage of the Internet. The listserv TC-PUBS, established by Katherine Durack and members of the Miami University Student Chapter of the Society for Technical Communication, is distributing abstracts for five technical communication journals, *IEEE Transactions on Professional Communication*, *Journal of Business and Technical Communication*, *Journal of Technical Writing and Communication*, *Technical Communication*, and *Technical Communication Quarterly*. To subscribe send a message to TC-PUBS@listserv.muohio.edu.

A second source is on the Web: EServer Tech Comm Library, tc.eserver.org. Geoffrey Sauer and University of Washington students are building a database-driven web portal for technical communication resources. The 12 categories are Academic, Articles, Books, Careers, Design, Humor, Journals, Organization, Random Recent, Reference, and Resources.

In addition to these initiatives, professional organizations are increasing Web access to publications and other information. IEEE Professional Communication Society and the Society for Technical Communication provide a number of resources for members. IEEE-PCS gives members access to the full text of the magazines, conference proceedings, and the journal *Transactions of the Professional Communication Society* since 1988. One feature of the database gives users the ability to search the references cited by IEEE-PCS authors. For its members, the Society for Technical Communication indexes its publications *Intercom*, *Technical Communication*, and *Proceedings*. Dissertation abstracts are also provided. For Intercom, a one-three sentence abstract previews the current issue. Past issues are indexed and are available in full-color .pdf files. The STC website (www.stc.org) is the most complete source for *Intercom* and *Proceedings*.

Technical communication teachers, students, and researchers now have several sources for locating resources.
